

Waldorf School of Bend Admissions Process

Nursery School – Child must be two years old at time of enrollment

- Submit **Nursery Application** with a \$50 non-refundable application fee.
- Upon receipt of your application, our Admissions Director will confirm requested days
- Nursery teacher will be in contact for phone or in person interview

Pre-Kinder/Kindergarten- Child applying for Pre-K or Kindergarten must be 3 years old at time of enrollment.

- Submit **Early Childhood Application** with a \$100 non-refundable application fee.
- Submit a TEACHER RECOMMENDATION FORM to any of your child's current teachers (if applicable).
- Upon receipt of your application and teacher recommendation form, the Class Teacher will contact you to set up an interview.
- Following the interview, you will be notified of acceptance by the Admissions Director who will set an enrollment meeting.

Elementary School (Grade 1-5) - Children applying to first grade must be 6 years old by May 1st.

- Submit **Grades/Jr. High Application** with a \$100 non-refundable application fee.
- Submit a TEACHER RECOMMENDATION FORM to any of your child's current teachers.
- Submit a RECORDS RELEASE FORM to your child's current school.
- When all three forms and the application fee are received by WSB you will be contacted by the Class Teacher to set up:
 - An initial interview with the Class Teacher.
 - A 3 day in-class visit for your child.
- Following these steps, you will be notified of acceptance by the Admissions Director who will set an enrollment meeting.

Middle School/Jr. High (Grade 6-8)

- Submit **Grades/Jr. High Application** and **Student Participation Application** with a \$100 non-refundable application fee.
- Submit a TEACHER RECOMMENDATION FORM to any of your child's current teachers.
- Submit a RECORDS RELEASE FORM to your child's current school,
- When all three forms, application fee, and current school transcripts are received by WSB you will be contacted by the Class Teacher to set up:
 - An initial interview with the Class Teacher.
 - A 3 day in-class visit for your child.
 - A follow up interview with the Class Teacher, as needed.
- Following these steps, you will be notified of acceptance by the Admissions Director who will set an enrollment meeting
